- Pscho-coustician to understand the effect of sound upon the ear and the brain
- Audiologist to understand the mathematics of music
- Linguist to understand the study of language and speech
- Neurologist to understand the effects of sound upon the nervous system and the brain
- Electrical engineer to be able to build different instruments for creating the measuring sound and music
- Philosopher to understand concepts behind music's creation and use
- Acupuncturist to understand Oriental medicine, including meridians and points
- Esoteric expect trained in all occult and spiritual subjects
- Psychic able to see etheric fields, prophesize, and communicate with unseen forces
- Magickian to understand the uses of chants and magickal formulas
- Healer trained in all traditions; chakras, bio-energetics, etheric fields
- Shaman able to induce and travel to different states of consciousness
- Vocalist able to create all techniques of chanting and toning form all traditions

LEVEL 1

LEVEL 3 (ADVANCED)

This is specially for students who have learnt Level 1 & 2 and are truly practicing.

The class aims at consolidating your foundation of singing bowl healing and teach you about how to bring people to deeper surface and create journey for the the client, such as rebirthing and going backward to reconnect to the past.

A lot of focus will be placed on how the therapist can prepare for client's response for the rewinding as they may have major reactions, emotions arose from the result of energy shift in their conscious mind.

Much of the teaching and sharing in this class is the derived from Rahul's direct experience with the Shaman in Sir Lanka and his blind teacher in Thailand.

The main practice in this class is about balancing water, fire and wind in the "Healing Tepee" format which is suitable for everyone and those in fragile health.
